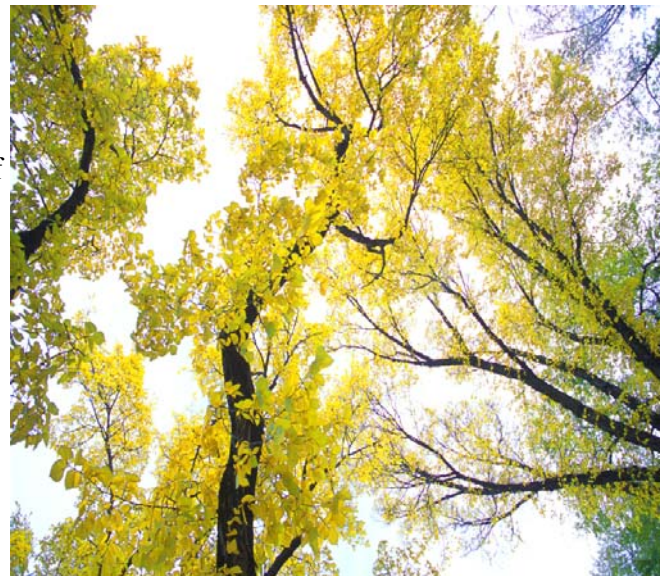

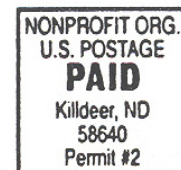
We work with the ND Forest Service on these programs:
